CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

- 15/08/2022 Independence day was celebrated with the special focus on "Har Ghar Tiranga" mission launched by the Government of India. Staff and students participated in it. - 3/09/2022 a seminar on "Eyes Donation" held in the college. Dr. Pankaj Bansal (SMO) from Civil Hospital Kotkapura delivered valuable information to students and staff. Officiating Principal Dr. Harish Sharma also motivated the students for eyes donation.

- On 28/09/2022 115th birthday of Shaheed Bhagat Singh was celebrated with a cycle rally from college to Village Dhilwa at 7.00 am. Students as well as staff members participated in it with great enthusiasm. In afternoon in the library of college, a seminar was organised. Prof. Sukhveer kaur enlightened students on the life of Shaheed Bhagat Singh. Prof. Poonam Arora presented a poem "Marte-Marte". Ashmeet Sachdeeva of B.A 3 and Vanshika of B.A 1 also shared life and thoughts of Bhagat Singh. A choreography on the contribution of Bhagat Singh for independence struggle was also shared with the students. Blood donation Camp with the support of PBG welfare club was also organised where students and staff members donated blood for social welfare.
- On 06/10/2022 Cyber Awareness Day was celebrated in college. Prof, Harpreet Singh informed students about various cyber-attacks and cyber crimes occurring these days. Prof. Ajay kumar further added the cautions students should take while using internet services. Dr. Harish Sharma, officiating principal alerted the students about losses and damages that can occur beoz cyber crimes.

- On 18/10/22 an NSS Camp against stubble burning was organised in the college with the support of District Agriculture Department. Deputy Director S. Khushwant Singh and Agriculture Officer S. - Final exams of even semester held in May 2022 which were conducted in offline mode.


